### CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY COUNSELOR REQUIREMENTS

Individuals must complete and submit an appropriate application, fee and all required documentation to be certified/licensed by the Board.

### FILE AN ONLINE APPLICATION

### **CDCA:** Chemical Dependency Counselor Assistant Preliminary (PHASE I)

- Must be at least 18 years of age and hold a High School Diploma or GED
- Forty (40) hours of CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY SPECIFIC EDUCATION in the required content areas
- Completion of ONLINE APPLICATION

# Students who complete 414/514-417/517 can apply for and receive the CDCA. This will enable them to gain employment while completing the hours needed for the LCDC.

### LCDC II: Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselor II

- An Associate's degree in a behavioral science or nursing OR a Bachelor's degree in any field
- One year (2,000 hours) of chemical dependency counseling related WORK EXPERIENCE (compensated work or supervised internship)
- 180 contact hours of CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY SPECIFIC EDUCATION in nine specific content areas. This will be provided by our five classes.
- 220 PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE hours in the twelve core functions. This may be completed as part of your work experience requirements
- Successful completion of the ADC examination or completion of EXAMINATION WAIVER FORM
- Completion of ONLINE APPLICATION

### LCDC III: Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselor III

- A minimum of a Bachelor's degree in a behavioral science or nursing
- One year (2,000 hours) of chemical dependency counseling related WORK EXPERIENCE (compensated work or supervised internship)
- 180 hours of CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY SPECIFIC EDUCATION in nine specific content areas.
- 220 PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE hours in the twelve core functions. This may be completed as part of your work experience requirements
- Successful completion of the ADC examination or completion of EXAMINATION WAIVER FORM
- Completion of ONLINE APPLICATION

- 180 hours of CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY SPECIFIC EDUCATION in nine specific content areas.
- 220 PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE hours in the twelve core functions. This may be completed as part of your work experience requirements
- Successful completion of the ADC examination or completion of EXAMINATION WAIVER FORM
- Completion of ONLINE APPLICATION
