The first ballot of the winter/spring 2019 semester -- an entirely at-large ballot -- is now closed. The JCU faculty voted on six motions: five faculty handbook amendments requiring a majority of the faculty eligible to vote in order to pass (89 of 177); and one motion requiring a majority of those faculty actually voting. The faculty passed all six motions.

An issue-by-issue summary of the vote follows. Canvas won't let me paste a screenshot in this space so I will send it out as an email.

Issue one: Motion to approve a faculty handbook amendment to revise the threshold to approve amendments to the faculty handbook.

Votes in favor: 104

Votes opposed: 55

Percentage of eligible faculty voting in favor: 59%

Percentage of votes cast in favor: 63%

Issue two: Motion to approve a faculty handbook amendment to revise the voting policy for faculty on leave.

Votes in favor: 143

Votes opposed: 14

Percentage of eligible faculty voting in favor: 81%

Percentage of votes cast in favor: 86%

Issue three: Motion to approve a faculty handbook amendment to revise the process of submitting and considering amendments to the faculty handbook.

Votes in favor: 119

Votes opposed: 36

Issue four: Motion to approve a faculty handbook amendment to revise the procedures for

distributing amendments to the faculty.

Votes in favor: 141

Issue five: Motion to approve a faculty handbook amendment to declare the electronic version of the handbook the official version.

Votes in favor: 150

Votes opposed: 10

Issue Six: Motion to approve a new policy on incomplete grades.

Votes in favor: 121

Votes opposed: 34

Abstentions: 8
